Recites: That the parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of \$25000, lawful money of the United States of America, to them in hand paid, by the party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged do by these presents, hereby convey and quit claim unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns all those certain Quartz Lode Mining Claims, situated in unorganized Mining District, County of Del Norte State of California, and more particularly known as the (Monumental No 1) (Monumental No 2) (South Prudential) (Prudential No 1) (Prudential No 2) (Montana) and (Surprise), the notice of location thereof being recorded in the mining records of Del Norte County, California, to which records reference is hereby directed for a more definite description thereof. Together with all the lode, vein, lodes and all the metals therein; and all the rights, privileges, and franchises, thereto incident, appertaining, and wherewith usually had and enjoyed.

... and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances the unto belonging, or in any wise appertaining, and wherewith usually had and enjoyed hereof;

... and all the estate, right, title, interest, claim or demand, whatsoever, as well in law as in equity, of the said parties of the first part, of, in or to the said premises, and every part and parcel thereof, with the appurtenances
