MINES AND PROSPECTS

In last week's Courier we published a report of the County Surveyor concerning the resources of Del Norte County outside of the forest reserve.

.....MONUMENTAL COPPER MINE

This mine was located by Charles Baker who later sold same to Col. T. Wain Morgan Draper for the sum of \$30,000. Col. Draper spent between \$200,000 and \$300,000 in blocking out ore and with transportation to the sea would be a paying mine. About five thousand feet of tunnels have been run, and shafts about four hundred feet down. Four hundred thousand tons of ore have been blocked out but the mine is doing nothing at present on account of lack of transportation facilities.

MANY MINES

Besides the above mines there are hundreds of prospects in the mountains between here and Grants Pass. Otto Anderson, Lew Graham and his mother, Wm. Ehrman, George Morgan, West Duley, O. B. Lauff, Frank Edwards and many others have locations in the Monumental country.....
