Dear Mr. Brickwedel:

I've just completed going through Steve Singer's field data from last season and I found a postcard postmarked November 12, 1980 in which you request some assay results for four samples collected from your property last summer. Steve returned to graduate school in August and I haven't been as diligent as I should have been tying up his loose ends. I apologize for any tardiness.

I've been able to locate the sample results and a brief description of the rock types, but I do not have an accurate location for the samples. Perhaps you already know where he collected them or can find a sample location tag at the sample site.

No. 9673: 3½ foot channel sample across a flat outcrop of silicified bleached, pyrite bearing tuff.

No. 9674: 3 foot channel sample of same material collected 15 feet north along strike. Minor pyrite noted along slate/tuff contact.

No. 9675: Composite of three 4 foot channel samples of same material collected approximately 30 feet north along strike from 9674.

No. 9676: 4 foot channel sample collected next to diamond drill site.


