Dear Mr. Perez,


Having been away, I am just now responding to your letter of July 26 regarding my Monumental Mine Property in Del Norte County

The property has had limited mineral exploration by two mining companies during the 1980's. The 15,000 tons you mention would have to be an underground mining operation since there is very little ore on the surface. Also to get \$500,000 worth of vein surface ore you mention wouldn't be possible for the above reason. The points you mention such as proof of the 40,000 ounces of gold, geologic mapping, etc. have already been accomplished by the mining companies.

Beside deeper core drilling at strategic locations, the deeper levels at the old underground workings should be opened. The underground have only been opened down to the first level, 40 feet. Are there any new geophysical metal detecting instruments that would work underground to detect veins or ore bodies?

At this stage what is needed is financing for deeper core drilling and opening up the underground workings to lower levels.
